The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a non-profit Corporation under and by virtue of the laws of California and for this purpose, we hereby certify that:

First: The name of the Corporation shall be "University of the Philippines Alumni Association of California, Inc."

Second: The place in this State where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is the City of San Francisco, County of San Francisco, California.

Third: The purposes for which this Corporation is formed are as follows:

Primary Purpose

Section 1.

- A. To provide for organized Alumni assistance to the University in the fulfillment of the mission as an academic institution: To this end it shall assist the University to raise funds required for its efficient operation, to endeavor to establish various scholarships, either thru organizational funds or by obtaining donations and other grants from University Alumni and others who are in a position to make such contributions.
- B. To perpetuate Philippine tradition and culture among its members and other Filipinos reciding in California. To this end it shall sponsor and participate in cultural programs and activities.
- C. To assist prospective members who are new in California to adjust to their new environment by lending them assistance in seeking jobs and good housing locations.
- D. To promote a better understanding and unity among its members reciding in California, in particular and in the United States in general.

Fifth: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

Sixth: The elected officers and their qualifications and duties, membership requirements, classes of membership, the property, voting proxies and other privileges and rights of members as well as their liability of payment of dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be set forth in the By-Laws.

Seventh: The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this coporation shall unure to the benefit of any private person or persons. Upon dissolution of this

and after winding up its assets, the balance if any after payment of provision for payment of all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated solely for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Eighth: This corporation is organized under and pursuant to the General Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of California.


